

Lake Sherwood Pump Station Rehabilitation Construction Status Update Week of May 3, 2021

Calleguas Municipal Water District is working on a project to rehabilitate the Lake Sherwood Pump Station, which is located approximately 400 feet southwest of 493 Hillsborough Street in Thousand Oaks.

Week of May 3, 2020

During the week of May 3, Calleguas' contractor will be working at the pump station site and also at Calleguas' Lake Sherwood Reservoir, which is up the fire road away from Hillsborough Street. On Wednesday, May 5, 2021, Calleguas' contractor will be working long hours to install critical valves on the pump station piping. It is expected that work will begin at 7:00 a.m. and conclude by 9:00 p.m. on May 5th; however, there is a possibility that working hours may continue beyond 9:00 p.m. that night. Calleguas will do everything it can to minimize this impact to adjacent residences.
